

I-Connect Guide for Alignment With Existing District Curriculums and Practices (Adapted from Technical Guide for Alignment of Initiative, Programs, Practices in School Districts (NCTAPBIS, 2017)).



When bringing a new practice to a system, it is important to make sure the practice fits well within the system. A practice that is aligned with the preceding goals and missions of the district/school will be easier to implement alongside existing programs and more sustainable.

To determine how I-Connect aligns with the current practices:

- 1. Identify what practices are in place that target student behavior and/or task completion. *This can include district-wide initiatives, curriculums, practices and common strategies that are often used by educators in the district/school.* 
  - a. It would be helpful to determine at this point if these other programs are firmly in place, or in need of review to ensure they are being used correctly.
  - b. If your district/school has not compiled a list of the current "practice landscape" in your school, this tool may be of use: <u>Technical Guide for Alignment of Initiative, Programs, Practices in School Districts</u> (hyper link: <u>https://www.pbis.org/resource/technical-guide-for-alignment-of-initiatives-programs-and-practices-in-school-districts</u>).
- 2. For each practice, include the leadership team/point of contact, what population the practice serves, research base of the practice, and outcomes achieved to date in the district/school.
